Positions for each school will be determined as follows:

The number of instructional unites for the school system will be determined according to Georgia law for determining instructional units based on full time equivalent (FTE). Special service units and other units that the school may earn will be added to the FTE units.

The number of positions at a school may be reduced or increased in proportion to the number of pupils anticipated for enrollment for the next school term.

Increases in positions over and above the earned allotment will be determined upon the recommendation of the superintendent and the approval of the Terrell County Board of Education.

The title programs and the regular school programs have been planned and budgeted to assure that Federal funds will supplement and not supplant state and local funds.

Positions for instructional and other services in the system for the next school term shall be determined upon the recommendation of the superintendent and approval of the Board of Education as follows:

After receiving reports of full time equivalent and instructional positions earned from the schools, and after consulting with local educational leaders, the superintendent shall determine the number and kinds of county wide services needed to provide a program of quality education for the next school term.

The superintendent shall recommend to the Board of Education the number of positions and personnel to fill the positions for the next school term or as these positions or vacancies occur.
