Members of the public wishing to complain about the curriculum or instructional materials must put in writing their concerns.

The complaint will then be referred to a committee, to be appointed by the Superintendent, which will review the complaint and the work in question. The complainant shall have the right to attend such committee meetings. If the committee decides that despite the complaint, the facet of the curriculum or the instructional material has merit in our instructional program, it may so decide. If the committee decides otherwise, it shall refer the matter to the Board.

In any case, a complainant dissatisfied with the committee's decision may appeal the matter to the Board.

Any parent has the right, to file a written request with the principal of his/her child's school, to remove any book or other item of instructional material from the child's curriculum.
